- Song should be in Sanskrit Language and in Devnagari Script only.
- Preference will be accorded to varying subjects content rich songs which is extensively using Sanskrit Language features like Sandhi, Samaasa, Kaaraka, Pratyaya (suffix), Vibhakti, Dhaaturoop (Verb form), Avyaya, Prefix, etc.
- Songs may be based on Early Childhood Care and Education as stated in NEP2020 also.
- It is necessary to provide translation and underling message in Devnagari script in Hindi as well.
- The sender should be the author of the song; it should be original and should not have been published earlier in any form. Translated songs will not be accepted.
- Submit the song in PDF. Also send its audio file in your voice for understanding its musical tones for subsequent audio recording by professional Sanskrit singers.
